- **Box a:** Employee Number, Unique to each employee
- Box b: Employer's Federal ID#
- Box c: Employer's name and address
- Box d: Employee social security number
- Box e: Employee's name

- Box f: Employee's address
- Box 1: Total amount of money earned during the year
- Box 2: Amount of employees earnings were taken out and paid to government as income tax (called: "withholding")
- Box 3: Amount of your overall wages subject to Social Security taxes
- **Box 4:** Amount of wages "withheld" and applied toward Social Security Trust fund (After paying into this fund for several years of paying into this fund, you are entitled to collect benefits when you are eligible.)
- Box 5: Wages and tips subject to Medicare tax are the same as those subject to social security tax (Boxes 3 & 7)
- Box 6: Wages withheld and applied towards Medicare Trust Fund
